Spirit or being who gave to Arthur the Excalibur, raised the Lancelot after the death of his parents and was one of the 3 women who took care of Arthurs's dying body. She is giving help whenever she is needed and she carries the attributes of the Mother.

King Arthur



Raised by foster father, he had become a King in his 16 years old, united the kingdom, and turned away the invasion of Saxons. He yielded a magical sword Excalibur. His wife cheated on him with his first knight, what sparked civil war. Killed while defeating his country against the invasion led by his illegitimate son Mordred.

Merlin



Magician, son of a Satan and woman, aid to the king to bed the wife of his enemy from which Arthur had been born. He took the newborn child and gave it to foster parents. After Arthur became a king, Merlin was his first counselor, yet he fell in love with the woman and was imprisoned by her in the cave without a chance to escape.

Tristan



Inspiration for Romeo, Tristan was one of the strongest knights of the Round Table who was ordered to bring an Irish princess Isolda to his uncle, the king of Cornwall. Tristan and Isolda fall in love, yet both of them have to marry someone else. When Tristan is mortally wounded, Isolda comes to see him and falls death along his side.

Galahad



The most virtuous of all knights, renowned for his gallantry and purity, pursuing the truth and righteousness. Son of Lancelot, carrying the strength of his father but not his sins, he is the one who had found a Holy Grail and upon touching it, ascend with it to heaven.

Percival



Half-orphan, living in the forest with his mother, once meets a group of knights and travels with them to the Arthurs court. There, sir Cei is mocking him. Percival set upon a journey to become a knight. He learns to be a son of a heroic sir Pelennor, comes back, defeats sir Cei in a duel, and joins the Knights of the Round Table.



Mordred



When it was foretold a child born in May will seal Arthurs doom, the king orders to murder all newborn kids. Only Mordred survived, an illegitimate son Arthur and his half-sister. Later, he becomes a knight of the Round Table, yet in the end, rebels against his father, lead a Saxons army to Britain, and before he is killed by Arthur, he manages to deal him with a mortal wound.

Morgana



The female counterpart of Merlin, powerful sorceress, sometimes helping to knights of the Round Table, sometimes plotting against them. Often depicted as a half-sister of Arthur and a mother of Mordred. Mischieving, even though she might pretend a submission, she is always rebellious and defying in the end. She carries the attributes of a Mistress.

Lancelot



Raised by a Lady in the Lake, he learned to be a son of a French king. Still, he decides to follow a king Arthur and becomes famous for his mastery in a sword. Yet, deeply in love, he cheats his honor and bed king's wife. He fought with Artur many times to protect Guinevere, yet after his death, he is entering the temple to become a monk.

Guinevere



Daughter of King Leodegrance, she is chosen to become Arthur's wife. She falls in love with Arthur's first knight, Lancelot, and has a romance with him. She is several times framed from treason, sentenced to death, and all the times saved by Lancelot. After Arthur's death, she is entering the convent and becoming a nun.

Kay



Foster brother of King Arthur, he always protected the throne. He loves to make fun of the others, very often in a quite rude way, yet however flawed he is, he is very faithful and protective and he many times proved his bravery.

Ector



Foster father of King Arthur, he is a loving and caring man who raised his sons to be brave and strong, yet honest men. He is carrying strong inner wisdom in and was always Arthur's counselor right after Merlin.
